

The Region System Goals 2014-2015

BETTER COMMUNICATION:

- Create a Region Calendar of events including all term plans of the Chapters in the Region
- Eventually add Job's Daughter/Rainbow functions ~ Submit to WA DeMolay to be uploaded to the State on-line calendar
- Create a Region Newsletter (distributed either digitally or hard copy / monthly or every other month)
- Each Chapter to select a "Chapter Representative" to the Region
- Assign responsibilities to Chapter Representatives (Ritual/ Fundraising/Membership/etc.)

HOLD REGION MEETINGS:

- Minimum of two ritual meetings - these will have either ritual training or put on the full degrees for candidates ~ perhaps hold a Region Ritual Competition
- Quarterly Roundtable meetings with Officers and Advisors
- Quarterly meetings need to be more than a meeting. They need to have a) an educational component, b) a sharing of ideas and upcoming events component and, c) must have a FUN component
- First Meeting of term select a Region Ritual Resource Team (create a list of who knows what): Initiatory Degree, DeMolay Degree, Chapter Installation
- Region Conclave - elect New Region Master Councilor, create a purpose for the Conclave, and have a FUN activity

TRAIN ADVISORS:

- Hold DAD Training Regularly
- Assign and Describe Specific Advisor Roles
- Encourage attendance at all State Sponsored Advisors Sessions
- Attend other Chapter Advisory Board Meetings

PUBLIC RELATIONS:

- Local Papers and Media
- Masonic Tribune and local Lodge Newsletters
- Sponsor regular Local Civic Service Projects
- Radio/TV Coverage for Civic Service Projects
- Participate in all local Parades

FRATERNAL RELATIONS:

- Increase and Support the Jo-Ra-De events
- Coordinate Term Calendars between Masonic Family Groups in Region
- Region Masonic Service Projects
- Local Masonic Service (Temple Cleaning)
- Ritual exemplification's for Local Masonic Bodies
- Field Trips to Masonic Sponsored Organizations (Shrine Hospital)
- Attend Masonic Family Organizations Installations Regularly
- Newsletter to Masonic Group in the Masonic Center re-conclave/awards/state events/etc

CHAPTER LEADERSHIP TRAINING:

- Provide personalized and local assistance via Region Master Councilor and Deputy
- Use the resources offered by WA DeMolay
- Work with the Chapter's Councilors to provide basic education at their regular Chapter meetings
- Provide material as needed (Term Plan, Budget, Calendar, By-Laws, Officer Duties, Meeting Plans, Membership Information, etc.)
