2016-2017 State Officer Elections

Are you interested in running for Elected State Office...



If you are interested in running for an Elected State Office then you will need to click here or go the website (New/Info - State) and checkout details for what you must do in order to be considered and approved to run for office by the Executive Officer. All letters of intent must be POSTMARKED by February 5, 2016 in order to be considered. You must mail them, or hand deliver, as electronic submissions will not be considered. Please read everything

completely as there are a changes to the qualifications to run for office. All details including the following deadlines can be found in the letter from our State Dad Advisor.

- Friday, January 1, 2016 Notice to Chapters requesting Letters of Intent to run for Elected State
 Office
- Friday, February 5, 2016 Deadline to submit Letters of Intent to the Executive Officer. Must be Postmarked no later than the deadline date (hand delivered is acceptable, emailed Letters of Intent will NOT be accepted);
- Saturday, February 13, 2016 Candidate Interviews (to be held during the State Ritual Competitions). Time schedule and location to be announced;
- 4. Sunday, February 14, 2016, 12:00pm "So You Want to be A State Officer Meeting" (discussion with candidates and parents about the responsibilities of being an Elected State Officer and details of the election process and rules). Will be held at the WA DeMolay Offices in Tacoma from Noon to 1:30pm. Mandatory for all candidates.
- Monday, February 15, 2016 Official Announcement of approved candidates and written notice to all candidate applicants.

As many of you heard at our last WADA we are now reporting new initiates a little different than we used to. Instead of sending any paperwork to the State office or to DI office, you will now enter all the info directly into the eScribe system and have it processed by



DeMolay International. You can Click Here to be taken to the system, where you can login and enter the details for your new initiates. You will also need a PayPal account or an electronic payment option ready when you do or you will not be able to complete the registration process.
