Ritual Competitions and Certifications at Conclave 2016

Deadline to enter is midnight, Friday, April 15th...

The only ritual events taking place at Convention this year will be the certifications for Flower Talk and Ceremony of Light as well as the competitions and proficiency examinations for the 1st and 2nd Degree Obligations. All other competitions were held prior to Leaders' Ball in

Reminder About Medical Release Forms

All youth must have one regardless of age ...

Just a quick reminder that all of our youth (under 21) must have a Medical Release (MR) Form on file with their Chapter and provided for all State Events when attending. This includes Special MR forms for events like Conclave and DLC where unique forms are used for those specific events.



Note that even if the youth is 18 or older, a MR Form is still needed! This includes all youth participants who are guests of DeMolay (ie, prospects, Squires, Jobies, Rainbow, etc). However, anyone over 18 can sign their own MR Form if they wish, but we need to keep one on file since we are responsible for their care while they with us until the age of 21. Our insurance company and lawyers are very clear that in DeMolay (and our guests), you are not 18 until you turn 21.

PLEASE look at the dates designated for your OV's and <u>let us know</u> if you will have any issues with the dates selected. We want to start the next year off with you onboard and ready to roll. Leadership requires planning and you are vital in this process for success!



2) Shortly after you check in at Conclave on Thursday, each Chapter Master Councilor and Dad Advisor will be handed a Chapter Evaluation by the EO. We need you to help form the basis of the State Officers focus for the coming months. Gather your Councilors, Chapter Dad and Chapter Chairman in the "Hang-Out" room for a quick sit-down. This should take no more than 10-15 minutes to complete if you work together. You will not be allowed to get any room keys until this Evaluation form is filled out completely, honestly, with thoughtful comments, and returned to the Executive Officer.

Reporting new Initiates...

As many of you heard at our last WADA we are now reporting new initiates a little different than we used to. Instead of sending any paperwork to the State office or to DI office, you will now enter all the info directly into the eScribe system and have it processed by



DeMolay International. You can <u>Click Here</u> to be taken to the system, where you can login and enter the details for your new initiates. You will also need a PayPal account or an electronic payment option ready when you do or you will not be able to complete the registration process. If you have any questions you can contact <u>Dad Gross</u> with your question and he will get you an answer or walk you through the process as needed.

All Members Must Be Proficient Now

In order to hold office or vote, you must be proficient...

Reminder to everyone, effective January 1, 2016, all members must be proficient in order to hold an Elected Office and/or Vote. This is applicable to Chapter, Region and State Offices.

have a chance to get proficient at Convention and Dad Brunson gave several ways to help each of our members with that task at WADA.


