Playing politics, sound bites, and grabbing headlines is the talk of today and the buzz on television.



But what does "chivalry" mean to our members in DeMolay? The Googled definition is: **the combination of qualities expected of**

an ideal knight, especially courage, honor, courtesy, justice, and a readiness to help the weak. Does this not sound like the Seven Precepts of DeMolay - vitures that are timeless.

At your next Chapter meeting take 10 minutes to explore this question with the member. Have a Bro Break and talk about what our DeMolay feel is "Chivalry".

Here are 10 simple suggestions from "AskMen.com" to help bring chivalry back.

- 10. **Small gestures** like helping her/him with putting on a coat. Men, this can go a long way toward making a girl feel spoiled, well taken care of, and you are paying attention.
- 9. Let the ladies go first. First in line, first to order at a restaurant, and first through a door.
- 8. A modern lady doesn't like a guy suggesting they can't handle a physical task, like carrying something. But male or female be courteous and **ask to share the burden**. Say something like "it might be a little easier/quicker if we both share the load, can I help you..."
