# I want your ideas. Promote DeMolay & Increase Membership

I asked this question when I joined DeMolay in 1980. Now 35 years later, I still ask it. But today, I also hear from everyone else asking me the "how?" There is no magic answer. Huge companies spend millions of advertising dollars day in and day out. But perhaps we can make a difference together...



I will tell you it is nothing simple, but there are <u>lots</u> of little steps we can all take to make a major impact to promote DeMolay and thus increase our membership.

- 1) **Share the word.** Each one of you is a salesperson. Share what you did at your last Chapter activity, meeting, or State event. Tell your friends what you did during the summer (WA Cup and WOO). Share info on the game night, movie overnighter, Magic Tournament, Car Wash, bowling and pizza party. IF you don't talk about DeMolay then no one will know about DeMolay.
- 2) **Be a Billboard.** Go to your closet. Two questions how many DeMolay shirts do you own and how many ties do you own? Yep, you are set to be a walking, talking, live-action billboard for DeMolay! You have a Chapter meeting every other week right? On the days of your Chapter meeting, put on your slacks, dress shirt and tie and wear it to school.
