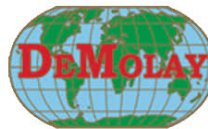

96th DeMolay International Session

Held in San Diego, CA... June 15-19, 2016

We just returned, literally, from the 96th Session of the International Supreme Council and 49th DeMolay Congress. Many ideas were shared, the committees relayed their work from the past year, honors were voted on and new officers were elected for the coming year ahead.



Washington was represented very well in the Congress by **SMC Luke Walker** and **DSMC John Jacobson** as your delegates. Luke proposed a three legislative items and all were passed by the Congress. If you would like to learn about those items please ask him about them. Also in attendance was **SSC Jared Pickett**. The new officers elected for the 50th Congress included recently retired SMC from Oregon, Gabriel Jones-Gallardo, who will represent Region 8 well over the next year as the International Congress Secretary, and Braden Zimmerman from Oklahoma who was elected as the International Master Councilor.

In the Supreme Council **Dad Brunson, Dad Gross, Dad Compton, Dad Nutter, Dad Reid, and Dad Rinehart** were in attendance to represent us diligently working on committees and active in the legislative items presented. The legislative call items will be shared in the next issue showing the detailed breakdown of what was passed and what was defeated. Also in attendance for a short time was **Dad Jacobson**. Elections were held and the officers of the Supreme Council all moved up, or remained in place from last year with Dad Boyd Patterson from Texas, being elected as the new Grand Junior Councilor. He has served for many years with the J&L committee and will represent DeMolay well. Our new Grand Master is Dad Bill Sardone from New York.

Your youth and adult delegates were able to meet others from different Jurisdictions from around the world and learn how they do DeMolay, steal ideas, make new friends and spent time seeing lifelong brothers. DeMolay International is now in 23 different countries and the list is growing. The Washington Delegation also found several times to sit down, talk, brainstorm, share ideas, discuss what they learned and work for your best interest of DeMolay in Washington.

WOFAB in Leavenworth

Registration is live on the state website...

As you may have already heard WOFAB will be in beautiful Leavenworth this year. The campgrounds are amazing and the experience is sure to be one of the best we've had in years. WOFAB will be **August 5-7** and the registration is live now and the deadline will be July 14th. You will want to be sure and read through all the N2K material that is currently available so you are clear about the costs and details for this years event. When the N2K packet is ready and available it will be posted on the website and we will also share it here. It will be \$12 per person and then additionally each site will cost either \$85 for tent use or \$120 for an RV. Each site can hold up to 6 people. So 6 people on a tent site would cost each person \$27, or \$32 for 6 people on an RV site. So depending on how many people you have going and the number of sites you wish to have will determine what your specific costs will be. Also each site can hold up to 2 vehicles. 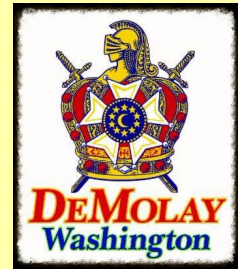

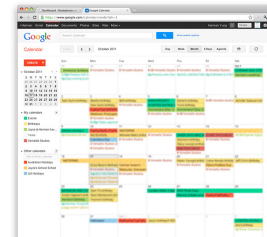
Please check with all your leaders...
