THANK YOU TO THE 115 DEMOLAY ADVISORS IN WASHINGTON THAT HAVE COMPLETED THE <u>ESCRIBE</u> REGISTRATION AND HAVE PAID THEIR 2017 ADVISOR FEES!

This has been a tough process that began October 1st, to get everyone who has *always and forever* done the registration process at an Annual Advisory Council Meeting (or been hunted down by the Chairman at their home, at their work, and even in a parking lot). Thank you to everyone I have bugged, emailed and begged to get this completed by Dec 10th.



However, I am sorry to say that we are down to crisis time for <u>4 Advisors</u> that have not completed the renewal process and an additional <u>14 Advisors</u> that still have their 2017 fees to pay.

Why am I pushing this so hard? Well, in the past we have had a little wiggle room because of the New Years Holiday and mail serivce. NOW, if you have not completed your 2017 online Advisor Registration, been approved by me, and paid your fee in full by Midnight, December 31, 2016, you will no longer be a DeMolay Advisor. 

When does a Member become a DeMolay officially Not everyone is registered as a DeMolay yet...

DeMolay International has a long-standing rule, governed by statute 321.3 of the DeMolay International Rules & Regulations, that new members shall be registered within 10 days of his Initiatory Degree and/or DeMolay Degree is conferred. According to the DeMolay International bylaws through the Jurisprudence & Legislation Committee, a member of DeMolay International does not officially become a member until he is registered with the corporation, 315.8.



Unfortunately, there are times when members are reported more than 10 days after the conferral of a degree. Because of this, membership numbers become inaccurate in the DeMolay Year (January 1 - December 31) when members are not reported properly.

Because of this Grand Secretary Keith K. Klein, PGM has issued the following statement: "Every day that goes by when a new Squire or DeMolay goes unregistered is another day that he does not have his new membership card, his patent, or other membership materials that certify him as a member of DeMolay International.

All members of DeMolay International are included as additional insureds for our General Liability policy, more importantly, guests of DeMolay are not. This means that members themselves, but not guests, would be defended under our policy if they're named in a lawsuit alleging negligence for bodily injury or property damage at an event. Members' additional insured status is provided by our policy's "Additional Insured - Club Members' endorsement.

Beginning January 1, 2017, for the purposes of Jurisdictional or Chapter membership awards and membership recognition, new members of DeMolay will not be counted toward a Chapter's new membership if the member is not registered with DeMolay International <u>within 10 days of his</u> <u>Initiatory Degree date.</u> This does not apply to individual awards such as the Blue Honor Key or the Founders Membership Award.

With eScribe, members can easily be registered at the Scribe's desk during the degrees! The process works well and is a simple way to ensure all members are registered in a timely manner and we are in direct compliance with our DeMolay International statutes."

Application deadline: February 28, 2017


Electronic submission is mandatory. Email complete application package to Becca Winner BWinner@DeMolay.org.
