

## **THANK YOU - DeMolay Advisor Renewal 2017**

We have 146 Washington DeMolay Advisors...

First, I am sorry if my bugging got a little over-the-top - but this has been a long three month tough process. We began October 1st, to get everyone who has *always and forever* done the registration process by filling out a hard copy paper form to change their mindset to doing it online. DeMolay International took a very stanch line that eScribe would be the only method that could be completed for renewals.



Second, if you did not renew and want to come back as a DeMolay Advisor, your only choice is

to start the process over (take the online Advisor Training, complete new Advisor forms, do the full background check, pay the \$48 new Advisor fee, and wait for the process to be completed). This will take aprox 30-45 days to complete. Chapter Chairmen please look at your Chapters Advisor Roster on eScribe (Rosters and Reports) to see who are your 2017 Advisors. You need to know who is and is not an Active Advisor for your Chapter.

Lastly, THANK YOU to everyone who had to listen to my urgent pushing to get the online registration completed. I am very proud that each of you found your way to logging into eScribe and were able to finish the forms. 
