A "Novice" is one who has been initiated longer than 6 months before Convention, but has not either placed 1st in the competition they want to compete in nor have ever served as a Chapter Councilor. A "Veteran" is one whom has previously placed 1st in that competition, is currently a Chapter Councilor, or has previously served as a Councilor.




