It is very important that you get your report completed and submitted to DeMolay International as soon as possible.

Login to eScribe and click on "Annual Chapter Report" under the registration tab as shown below. On the next screen you should see your Chapter listed. Click on the "view/edit report" highlight and it will open the report for you to begin.

You will need to have your chapter's financial information for the year in addition to any information about the activities of the Chapter during the past year. **DO NOT worry about the part asking you to file your Chapter's 990 as Dad Reid is doing that for you**.

You will be able to save your progress and come back to the report if you need to before submitting. Please be sure to check that you see all Advisors and new members from the **past year reflected in the report**. This will take a little longer than many of the other processes in eScribe, so please start early to give yourself enough time to complete it properly.
