

DeMolay International Centennial Session If you weren't there, you missed a great party...

A Quick Report on the Centennial Celebration

One-Hundred Years of DeMolay were drawn together in Kansas City for a week long Celebration from June 24th to 30th. DeMolay Congress consumed the first two days with debates on various legislation, committee reports, nominations, caucuses, and elections of the Congress Officers. Tyler Moyer of Pennsylvania was elected International Master Councilor and Jared Replogle of Arizona was elected International Congress Secretary. We attended the York Rite Leaders Dinner and the Newbury Luncheon, took a DeMolay Historical Tour of Kansas City, laid



flowers at the grave site of Dad Frank Sherman Land, and joined 1400+ of ourbrothers and closest friends at the Service and Leadership Center for BBQ, music, history, and the ribbon cutting of the Charity EnShrine Courtyard.

Halfway through the week we witnessed the Centennial Degree ofKnighthood, the Historical Ebon Degree, and exemplification of the 1924 DeMolay Degree. We also spent time enjoying each others company at a Washington Delegation Lunch at "The Yardhouse" and the PNW Dinner at "Joe's County Road BBQ". The Supreme Council began its busy agenda of 17 Legislative Call Items. The Centennial Grand Master Boyd Patterson, Jr. conducted a very efficient session plowing through business and reports. We passed adding a Squire's Honor Award, revised several sections of the Merit Bars, created the Master Squire's MSA, cleaned-up language in a few areas of the By-Laws, allowed for telephonic/video conferencing for Board of Directors meetings, and defined attendance at businesssessions. We elected John Whitaker of Tennessee as Grand Master, Marc Bohn of Georgia as Grand Senior Councilor, Vince D'Aguanno of Michigan as Grand Junior Councilor, Greg Chiles PGM as Grand Treasurer, and Keith Klein PGM as Grand Secretary.

The highlight of the Hall of Fame Banquet was a historical look back attach Senior DeMolay previously inducted into the Hall of Fame. Also GM Patterson made a surprise announcement that the original Nine DeMolay's would be the 2019 Inductees into the Hall of Fame. The Grand Master's Banquet and Installation wrapped-up and put a big bow on the Centennial year and gave us hope and inspiration to lead forward as we Carry the Flame into the next 100 years.

Updates from the meeting at session...

Greetings from Region VIII!

You may not know this but DeMolay International is broken up in various Regions much like DeMolay in Washington State. Internationally there are 10 Regions - we are in Region VIII which is made up of Southern California, Northern California/Hawaii, Oregon, Idaho, Alaska, and Washington. Every odd year (2019) we elect a Region Representative who serves on the DI Board of Directors for a two year term. The BOD meets once a quarter (3



times in Kansas City and then at the ISC Session) to conduct the business side of DeMolay, approves the Budget, and oversees the International fraternity and multi-million dollar Corporation that is called "DeMolay International". Each Representative is term-limited to two consecutive terms. Dad Jeff Brunson was re-elected for his second term.

The other duties include communicating to the Executive Officers in the Region the business and news from DeMolay International, overseeing the Koch Essay, and coordinating an Annual Region Meeting for the Elected Jurisdictional Officers, EOs, and Jurisdictional Staff. Region VIII happens to have a very large chunk of land and distance between the various states, so this has proven not to be the easiest thing to do. However, we all came to an agreement to hold a Region Meeting on October 4th and 5th in the Seattle area.

During our Region meeting at the ISC Session each Jurisdiction gave areport on how they are doing, shared ideas and voiced how DI can better serve them. We had over people 40+ in attendance and as usual many discussions about DeMolay followed plus lots of catching up with old friends and making new ones.
