





IRS Change for Group Exemption

Chairman please read and submit...

Earlier this year, the IRS notified DeMolay International of a change in procedure for registering our subordinate units as part of the group exemption process for 501(c)(3) status.

We want to make sure that every DeMolay entity in the United States (Chapter, Manor, Priory, Jurisdiction, Court, Preceptory, Alumni Organization, etc.) that is entitled to be part of the group exemption is included when the new list is filed later this fall. To help facilitate this, we are requesting that the Advisory Council Chairman or adult presiding officer of each entity complete the Group Exemption Request Form no later than August 31, 2019.
