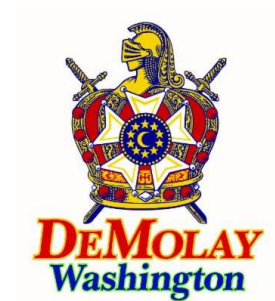


Where has the summer gone...

Washington DeMolay Announcement

New State Junior Councilor & State Scribe...

August 24, 2019

Greetings DeMolay in Washington,



Outlined in the Washington State DeMolay By-Laws, Article VI, Section 11 is the process when a vacancy occurs in an Elected State Office. Since the vacancy was at State Junior Councilor, there is no lower officer to automatically succeed that office. (State Scribe is not and was not intended to be a subordinate or lower office to the State Junior Councilor, but rather a lateral officer that serves Washington DeMolay as a member of the State Corps.)

Led by your SMC, the State Officers and State Dad Advisor held a great discussion looking to the future of our jurisdictional leadership and what would be best served for DeMolay in Washington

Following such, SMC Jenkins with the approval of SDA Dad Luedke and myself, has appointed **Bro. Kurtis P. Copeland as your new State Junior Councilor and Bro. Chase R. Dickinson as your new State Scribe to serve the remainder of the 2019-2020 Term.**

They have immediately assumed the various responsibilities of their Offices and will be reassigned specific tasks and State Events by the State Master Councilor as we continue to move forward to **#ExperienceDeMolay**. Please join us at Investiture Day / Hockey Night on October 19th when Kurtis and Chase will be formally installed.

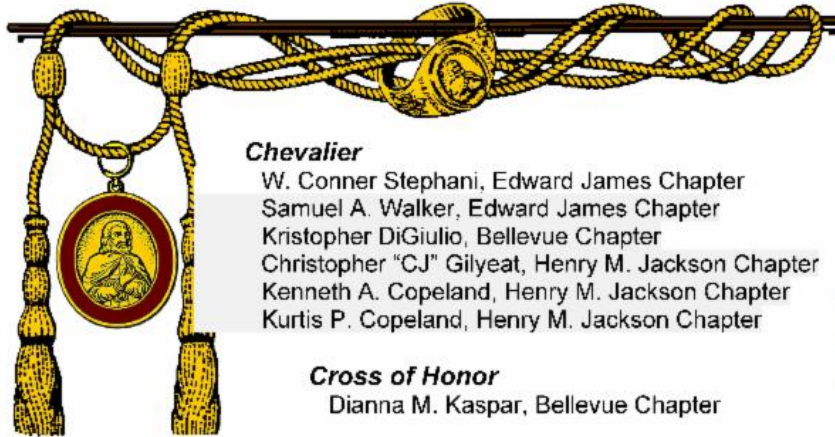

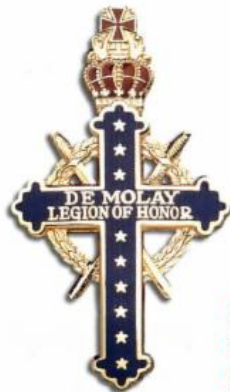

IRS Change for Group Exemption

Chairman please read and submit...

Earlier this year, the IRS notified DeMolay International of a change in procedure for registering our subordinate units as part of the group exemption process for 501(c)(3) status.

We want to make sure that every DeMolay entity in the United States (Chapter, Manor, Priory, Jurisdiction, Court, Preceptory, Alumni Organization, etc.) that is entitled to be part of the group exemption is included when the new list is filed later this fall. To help facilitate this, we are requesting that the Advisory Council Chairman or adult presiding officer of each entity **complete the Group Exemption Request Form no later than August 31, 2019. A big thank you to the several Chapters who have already done so.**
